# Hop to it (Part 1)

### 1. Opening Prayer

- Ask kids about their weeks, hardships
- Ask if there are prayer requests
- 2. Worship (song on www.voyagechurchmtl.com/teachers)

### 3. Game #1

You'll Need: Dry erase board and marker

#### Play

- Use the dry erase board, dry erase marker, and paper towel to play "Draw a Bunny."
- 2. Starting with the first word on the Bible Story Sheet, draw the correct number of blanks on the dry erase board. Choose one child to guess a letter to go in the blanks.
  - If the letter is in the word, write the letter in the correct blank(s).
  - If the letter is not in the word, draw a body part of the bunny (head, face, ears, body, feet, arms, tail). Allow kids to take turns guessing letters until the word is guessed or the bunny is fully drawn. Repeat for each section of the Bible Story Sheet.

#### Then ask:

- What breaks our friendship with God? (Our sin)
- True or False: Because Jesus never sinned, He was the perfect sacrifice to take the punishment for the sins of all people. (True)
- Who did Jesus give His life for? (All people) Yes, when we admit that we're sinful, believe that He died and rose again, and choose to follow Him with our lives, we can live forever in heaven with God one day!

# 5. Game #2

1. Divide the group into two teams. Then place the Basket Cards in the center of the group with the Easter basket side up.

2. Alternating teams, allowing kids to take turns tossing a beanbag onto a Basket Card.

3. Pick up a Card and read the hints on the back without showing the picture.

4. Award a point to the team if they guess the item correctly. For an extra challenge, award two points if they can guess correctly without hearing all hints. Once the game is over, read the Question Sheet.

5. **Say**: Let's say today's Need to Know together:

Jesus (point up) Gave His Life (palms up) For Me (thumbs to chest)

# 6. Closing Prayer

- o **Ask** kids what they'd like to talk with God about.
- Lead prayer or help kids pray for each other.

- Easter coloring pages and worksheets
- Play a game like Would You Rather or The Mirror Game.
