

Show God's Love

1. Opening Prayer

- Ask kids about their weeks, hardships
- Ask if there are prayer requests

2. Worship (song on www.voyagechurchmtl.com/teachers)

3. Game 10 minutes

You'll Need

Per Kid 1 Drawing Grid activity sheet

Per Group 1 Mini Art card set

1 Set of Markers

1 Pair of scissors

To Do

1. **Cut** across dotted lines on Mini Art card set to create 12 cards.

Say: When you're trying to help someone understand something, it's better to show them than to yell it at them. Let's play a picture-copying game about that right now!

2. **Give** each kid a Drawing Grid activity sheet and a marker to draw with.

Say: I'll tell you what to copy instead of showing you. But don't worry—I promise I won't yell it at you! Draw it the best you can, and we'll see who can draw it the closest to it.

3. **Describe** the art/design you see in one of the Mini Art cards, but **do not show** the art itself to the kids. *See Show & Yell activity supplement on back for ideas.*

4. Kids **draw** what you describe in Box 1 of their sheet.

5. **Reveal** the Mini Art card and **choose** the winner (the child with the art that looks the most like your card)!

6. **Play again** as time allows, choosing different cards to describe from your card set. *See back for more ideas!*

5. Discussion

Point: Share God's love with everyone. Pass it on!

Verse: John 8:12 NLT ... *"I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness ..."*

Choose a Question to Get Your Group Talking

- Jesus said the most important things are to love God and love others. What do you think is so important about loving God and loving others?
- What's better about showing *and* telling about God's love instead of *just* telling?
- What tips do you have for someone who wants to show God's love to others?
- If someone told you about Jesus but they acted like they were better than you, what would you think?

6. Closing Prayer

- **Ask** kids what they'd like to talk with God about.
- **Lead** prayer or help kids **pray** for each other.
