

Share Good News

1. Opening Prayer

- Ask kids about their weeks, hardships
- Ask if there are prayer requests

2. Worship (song on www.voyagechurchmtl.com/teachers)

3. Game 10 minutes

You'll Need

- 1 Good News activity sheet
- 1 Pen or pencil

To Do

We're going to talk about the best news ever today: God's good news! But first, let's have fun finishing a story together that's all about how good you can feel from hearing some good news!

1. Sit in a circle and let your group choose which story to fill out on your Good News activity sheet.
2. Read the print underneath the first blank in the story to let your group know what type of word you need. For example: "I need you to tell me a type of animal."
3. Ask one kid in your group to pick a word to fill in that blank and write the word they say in the blank.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the rest of the blanks in the story. Choose a different kid to pick a word each time. If you still have blanks left after each kid has had a turn, let kids have another turn!
5. Once all blanks are filled in, read the completed story to your group and enjoy its silliness!
6. If time allows, fill in and read the other story

5. Discussion

Point: Share God's good news with everyone. Pass it on!

Verse: John 8:12 NLT ... "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness

- What do you like about this Bible verse?

Choose a Question to Get Your Group Talking

- How do you feel when you hear good news?
- Share something good about Jesus that you want people to know.
- How is the good news about Jesus better than any other good news?
- The good news about Jesus changes people. What might change about someone when they choose to follow Jesus?

6. Closing Prayer

- **Ask** kids what they'd like to talk with God about.
- **Lead** prayer or help kids **pray** for each other.

7. Activity

8. Extra time

- Help kids talk with each other and build friendships.
- **Play a game like Would You Rather or The Mirror Game.**
