## **SERIES / MAIN POINT: LEAD LIKE JESUS. (WEEK #2)**

*Bible Passage: Ephesians 6:1-3 – Serve Your Parents*

### **Summary:**

Today we continue a series about how to lead like Jesus. As followers of Jesus, we want to put others first and have a servant attitude. For kids, the first step in leading like Jesus is serving their parents. Kids must obey and honor their parents. When they do, they begin developing the kind of servant attitude that will, hopefully, continue with them for the rest of their lives.

### **KNOW, FEEL, and DO:**

We want our kids to know that leading like Jesus will lead to a better, more fulfilling life. We want them to feel the joy and purpose of serving others like Jesus serves us. This week, we want them to find practical ways to serve some of the most important people in their lives – their parents.

### **Groups Start**

- Take tags
- Ice Breaker Q's (for example: "How was your week? Anything fun or exciting happen?", etc.)

### **Discussion Time #1 – Opening Discussion**

What do you like the most about your parents or guardians?

### **Discussion Time #2 – Application Questions**

READ: Ephesians 6:1-3

IMAGINE: Being in charge of your parents for a day... Yep – you're in charge!

- What changes would you make in your home? How would the day go overall?
- Would these changes serve your parents and your family or just serve yourself? Why or why not?

SHARE: As their Coach, take a few minutes to share with your kids. How does leading like Jesus by serving your parents help bring joy and purpose to your life? How does it help your relationship with God and just life in general? (*Hopefully, you've already experienced the promise that life will go well and you will continue to experience the promise of living a long time on the earth!*)

TAKE ACTION: As their Coach, encourage your kids to take their next step of trusting Jesus. Each kid is different, so think about what each kid needs to do. This week, how can you serve your parents? Obviously, you start by obeying and honoring them. (*Examples: obey right away, speak with kindness, do extra chores, etc.*)

PRAY: That you would all make the most of serving opportunities this week and have an attitude like Jesus.
