SERIES / MAIN POINT: LEAD LIKE JESUS. (WEEK #4)

Bible Passage: Mark 12:30-31 – Serve All People

Summary:

Today we continue a series about how to lead like Jesus. As followers of Jesus, we want to put others first and have a servant attitude. This attitude applies to all people all the time. That's why Jesus told us to "love your neighbor as yourself". Every person is created in God's image and needs the same love that we need. Jesus showed his love by serving us – even to the point of dying for us. By serving other people, we show them the same love.

KNOW, FEEL, and DO:

We want our kids to know that leading like Jesus will lead to a better, more fulfilling life. We want them to feel the joy and purpose of serving others like Jesus serves us. This week, we want them to find practical ways to serve any person that maybe they've overlooked in their lives.

Groups Start

- Take tags
- Ice Breaker Q's (for example: "How was your week? Anything fun or exciting happen?", etc.)

Discussion Time #1 – Opening Discussion

Who's your favorite neighbor? What do you like about them so much?

Discussion Time #2 – Application Questions

READ: Mark 12:30-31

IMAGINE: Having \$1 Million to use any way you wanted... You're finally a millionaire!

- What would you change with all that money?
- Would these changes serve others around you or just serve yourself? Why or why not?

SHARE: As their Coach, take a few minutes to share with your kids. How does serving people help bring joy and purpose to your life? How does it help your relationship with God? (*Hopefully, it helps you grow closer to God, as you're being more like Jesus Who served the whole world.*)

TAKE ACTION: As their Coach, encourage your kids to take their next step of trusting Jesus. Each kid is different, so think about what each kid needs to do. This week, how can you serve the people around you? Maybe you can start with some actual neighbors that live close to you and your family?

PRAY: That you would all make the most of serving opportunities this week and have an attitude like Jesus.
